***Room to breathe* report:**

Version 2 of *Room to breathe* – clinical audit report 2024/25 was published on 11 August 2026, following an original publication date of 11 June 2026. This version corrects an error in the chart label for Key Performance Indicator (KPI) 2 for adult asthma:

- The chart label on page 6 has changed from 'KPI 2: An exacerbation severity was recorded in the patient notes at initial assessment' to 'KPI 2: Peak flow (PEF) measurements taken within 1 hour of arrival at hospital'. The associated data in the report remains correct. The description and data within the benchmarked report data and full data file also remains correct and is unaffected.

***Room to breathe* data files:**

Version 2 of the *Room to breathe* adult asthma 'full service-level data file' and 'raw data file – for analysis' was also published on 11 August 2026, following an original publication date of 11 June 2026. This corrects an error in the presentation of ethnicity data which incorrectly split the below ethnicity categories:

- Patient ethnicity: Any other Asian background has been amended to 524 and the percentage has been corrected to 2.6%;
- Patient ethnicity, Any other Black background has been amended to 213 and the percentage has been corrected to 1.0%;
- Patient ethnicity: Any other White background has been amended to 676 and the percentage has been corrected to 3.3%;
- Patient ethnicity: White and Asian has been amended to 70 and the percentage has been corrected to 0.3%;
- Patient ethnicity: White and Black African has been amended to 76 and the percentage has been corrected to 0.4%;

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- Patient ethnicity, White and Black Caribbean has been amended to 98 and the percentage has been corrected to 0.5%.
