Opportunities for researchers


The Falls and Fragility Fracture Audit Programme (FFFAP) welcomes and encourages applications to use its data.

Data are collected by the programme via three national audits:

- > National Hip Fracture Database (NHFD)
- > National Audit of Inpatient Falls (NAIF)
- > Fracture Liaison Service Database (FLS-DB)

Data collection started in 2008 with the NHFD, 2016 for FLS-DB and in 2019 for the NAIF continuous audit. We have also collected data for snapshot audits such as the Anaesthesia Sprint Audit of Practice and Physiotherapy Hip Fracture Sprint Audit.

Depending on the level of data complexity you require, data may be free to access.
